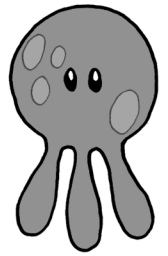


LUCY THE OCTOPUS

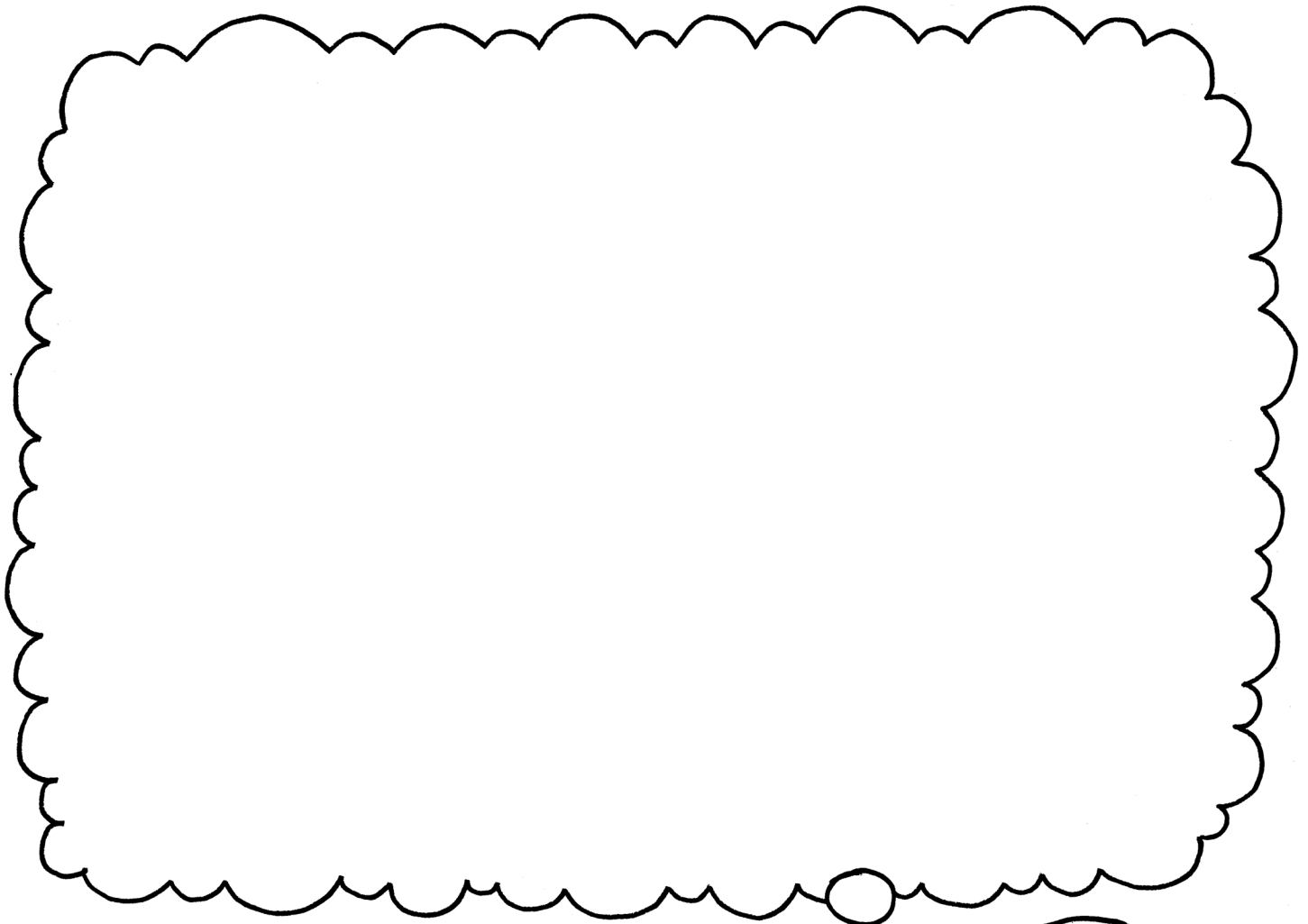


Draw a Friend for Lucy
